ARTICLE 35

BULLETIN BOARD AND MAIL SERVICES

The Union shall have the right to post notices with an appropriate Union identification, regarding activities and matters of Union concern on designated bulletin boards, at least one (1) of which shall be provided at each site in areas frequented by Classified Bargaining Unit Members.

The Union may use the District mail service for communications to Classified Bargaining Unit Members. Copies of all Union material posted or distributed for general Union information shall be mailed via District mail to the Superintendent or designee in a specially designated envelope indicating immediate delivery to the Superintendent or designee prior to the time the information is posted, distributed, and/or placed in the District mail.
