The United Steelworkers - California (Sub-District 1) is awarding nine (9) \$1,500 scholarships to high school seniors graduating in May 2023, whose parent or guardian is a current classified employee of the **Fontana Unified School District** and an active dues paying member of the USW Bargaining Unit Local 8599.

Any qualified graduating senior who plans to enroll in an accredited college or university needs to submit a completed application to the Union office. You can pick up an application at the Union office or request one to be sent to you.

The deadline for submission is Monday April 10, 2023 at 4:30 p.m. No exceptions.

Phillip Murray Scholarships

Each scholarship for \$1,500.00 will be awarded to the qualified graduating seniors from the following schools: A.B. Miller High School, Birch High School, Citrus High School, Fontana High School, Jurupa High School, Kaiser High School, and Summit High School and out of the district graduating seniors.

The eligibility requirements are:

You must provide the following information: a completed Phillip Murray Scholarship Application, copy of your transcripts and the required short essay (see attached). **Application must be signed by the student and the Financial Secretary of your Union Local 8599.**

2023 PHILIP MURRAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

UNITED STEELWORKERS – DISTRICT 12

One scholarship, each with a value of \$1,500.00, is to be made available for use during recipients' first year at any accredited college, university, vocational or technical institution in the United States or Canada. Scholarships will be awarded in May 2023 by the Scholarship and Existence Fund, USW District 12, as determined by a selection committee comprised of professional educators.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

1. Children, stepchildren, or legal wards of active members of local unions affiliated with the Scholarship and Existence Fund, United Steelworkers, District 12;
2. Must have a 2.75 GPA or better during junior or senior year in high school; and,
3. Graduate from high school in 2023.

The Philip Murray Memorial Scholarship does not discriminate based on sex, gender identity, national origin, sexual orientation, race, religion (including non-belief), political affiliation and intended course of study.

Available 2023 Phillip Murray Memorial Scholarships:

- California (Sub-District 1): 9 Awards
- Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, and Utah (Sub-District 2): 2 Awards
- Oregon, Alaska, Hawaii, Washington and Idaho (Sub-District 3): 3 Awards

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Applicants must fill out the attached application form and secure the signature of the member's local union financial secretary to indicate active union membership and applicant relationship eligibility;
2. Prepare a short (300-500 words) essay outlining **"What effect does a strong labor movement have on the working class in a democratic society?"**; and,
3. Mail the completed application, essay and high school transcript, **postmarked by April 15, 2023**, to The Scholarship Committee, United Steelworkers District 12, to the respective address below:

CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD: Recipients of the 2023 Philip Murray Memorial Scholarships will have arrangements made for the payment of their first year's tuition, fees and books up to a maximum of \$1,500 with the official of the institution charged with administration of scholarships. The Scholarship payment will be made when a copy of the recipient's acceptance letter from the learning institution is presented to United Steelworkers. Should the recipient fail to send the requested information and acceptance letter from the learning institution by December 31, 2023, the award will be invalid. Incomplete or late submissions will not be considered.

Recipients of the scholarships and participating local unions will be notified by letter from USW District 12; award decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final. District 12 wishes you all the best in your educational endeavors.
